Vision and Mission of Dorakids

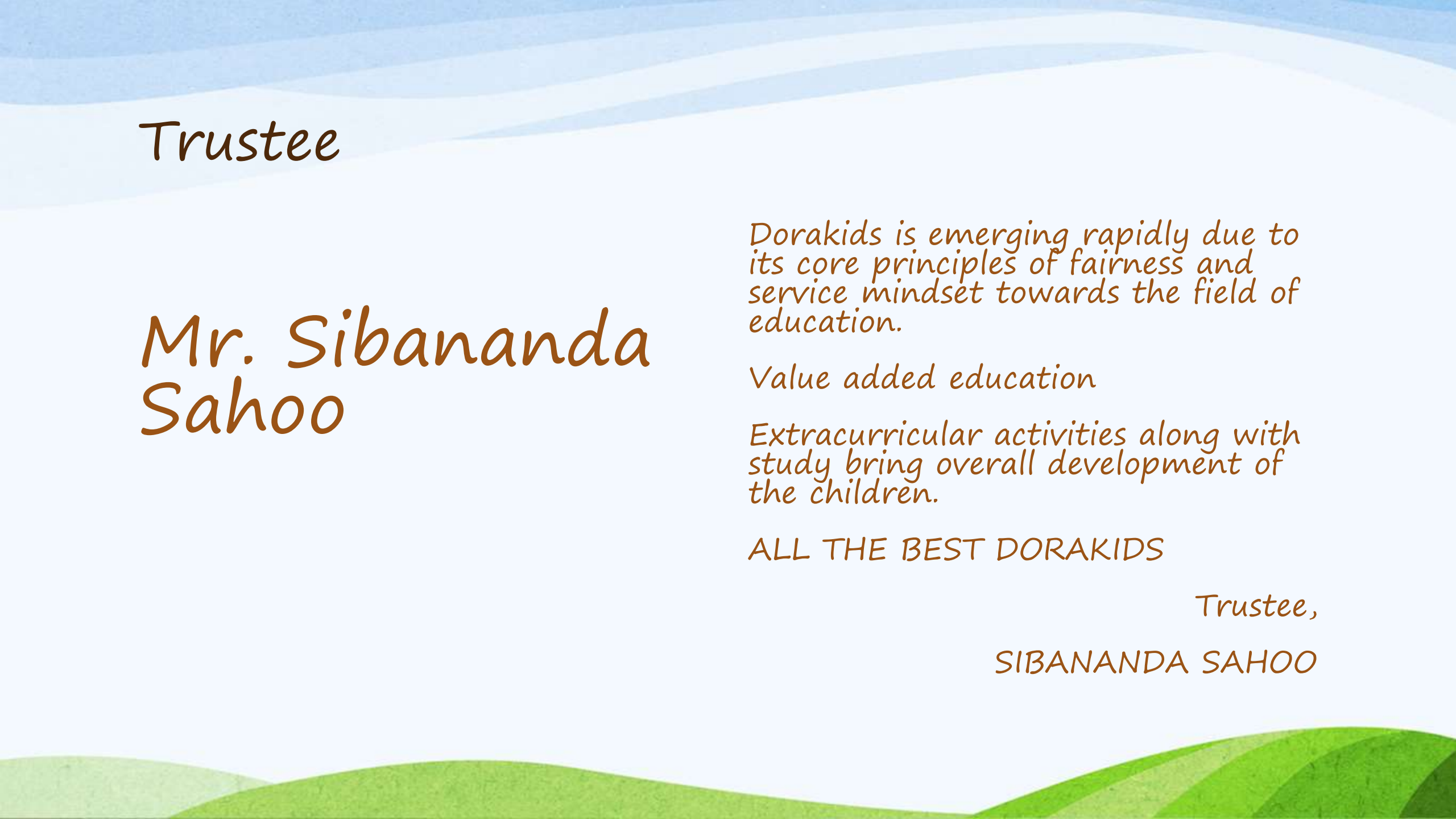
VISION:

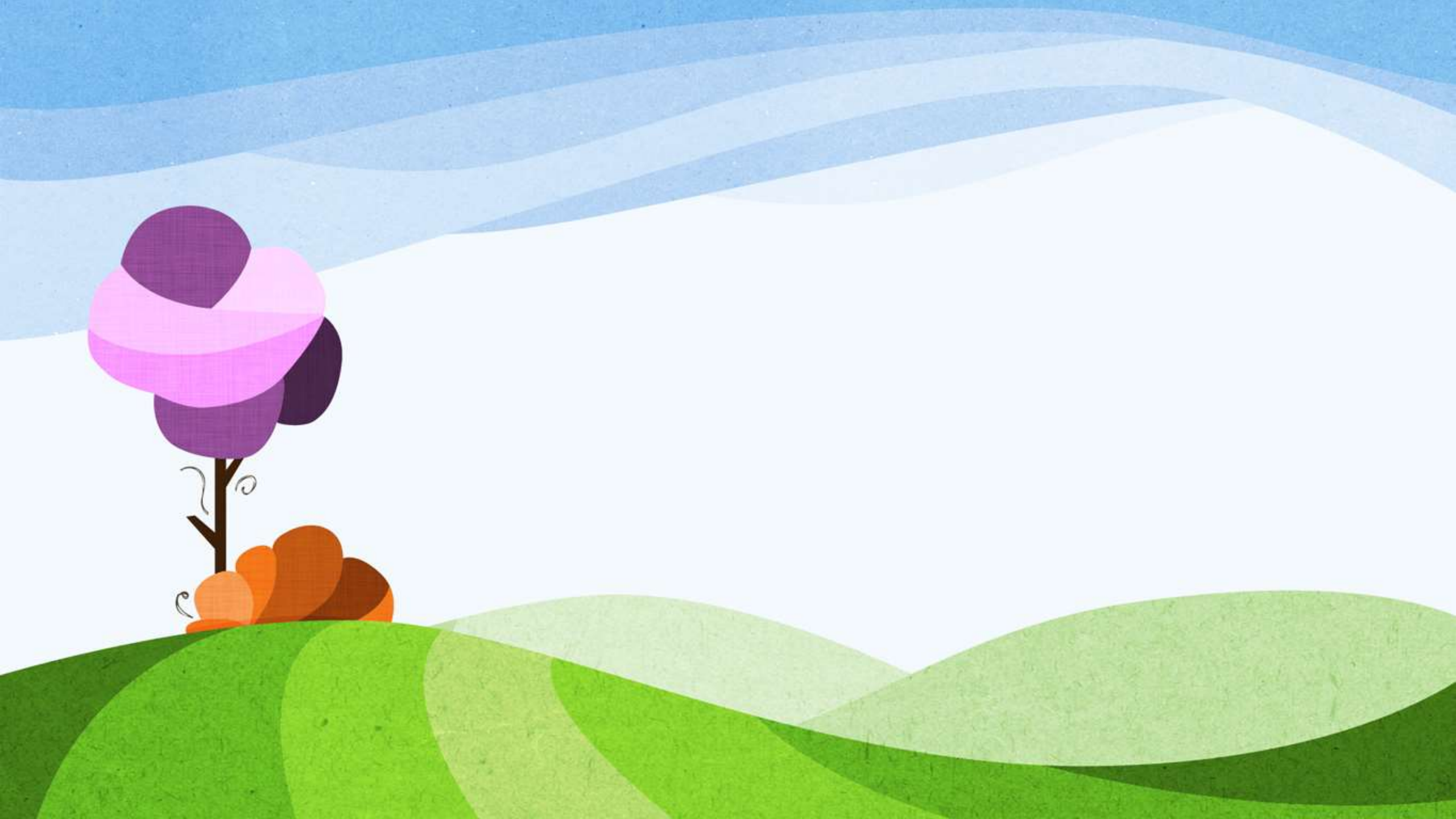
